



Visiting Landashir (ENG)

Passport/ID requirements, access to the territories, contacting the Agency

Landashir is a landlocked territory in the south of the island of Great Britain – this settlement is called “Sycamore Booker”.

It is also a residential territory, which means that the entire country is a home to the people who live there.

The residents have a right to decide what restrictions can be put in place to prevent unwanted visits and disturbances. The following has been composed taking into account the wishes of the residents of the Community of Landashir.

Please read this document if you are considering visiting the Community of Landashir.

Regulations of the Agency for Territories and Border Control: Visiting Sycamore Booker

Landashir'n citizens who are registered residents of Sycamore Booker are entitled to be there at any time. All residents of Sycamore Booker are **de facto** citizens of the Community of Landashir. As the territory is their domestic dwelling, they are permitted to live there and have their own privacy. Visitors and expatriated Landashir'n citizens are not.

For Landashir'n citizens *who are not* residents of Sycamore Booker

Being a Landashir'n citizen **does not** give somebody *right of abode* in a residential territory. A Landashir'n citizen may not simply turn up. A Landashir'n citizen who is **not** a registered resident of a residential territory must inform the Agency for Territories and Border Control of their intention to visit beforehand.

They must provide the following information:

- Their reasons for visiting
- Their travel plans (including date of arrival and departure)
- What they intend to do whilst in Landashir

The Agency for Territories and Border Control reserves the right to refuse entry. Successful applicants will be notified.

For registered residents of Sycamore Booker

Residents of Sycamore Booker are entitled to enter the territory at any time. They will be issued with keys to enter the territory at any time and are nominally exempt from the regulations of passport control, customs and excise.

For international visitors

All visitors who are not Landashir'n citizens must contact the Agency for Territories and Border Control before visiting Sycamore Booker. **Unless they are invited by the Landashir'n Government to visit**, they must provide the following information:

- Their reasons for visiting
- Their travel plans (including date of arrival and departure)
- What they intend to do whilst in Landashir





The Agency for Territories and Border Control reserves the right to refuse entry. Successful applicants will be notified.

Visits from the United Kingdom for essential services (repairs et al.), deliveries and guest visits are not bound by the regulations in this document. The residents of Sycamore Booker may open the border at their discretion for this purpose.

Nevertheless, the border between the Community of Landashir and the United Kingdom is officially closed for international visitors and non-residential citizens of the Community of Landashir. When residents are expecting a visitor, the border is opened temporarily. The border is manned by residents of the territory on behalf of the Agency for Territories and Border Control.

Passport checks are infrequent and happen rarely – when the border is open, the Landashir'n Government operates a policy of free movement. Customs and excise will go into operation on a case by case basis at the discretion of the residents of the territory. However, all visitors must carry a form of identification on their person at all times.

Where a passport check is required, the Agency for Territories and Border Control accepts the following forms of identification:

- Passport – must include a photo page and details of the issuing authority
- ID card of a member state of the European Union and the European Economic Area
- UK/ROI full and provisional driving licence card (paper licences are not accepted)
- Landashir'n national Identity Card (*Identificatiounskaart*) [for non-residential citizens of the Community of Landashir in Sycamore Booker]
- Any form of identification issued by the government of the following states:
 - o Empire of Austenasia (including any dependent territories)
 - o Federal Republic of St.Charlie
 - o Commonwealth of Zealandia
 - o State of Sandus (all states)

All documents must be valid for the duration of the bearer's visit to the territory

Further regulations and advice

Motor vehicles of any kind are not permitted on Landashir'n territory. They must be left outwith Landashir'n territory and the Agency for Territories and Border Control cannot be held responsible for anything which happens to them during a scheduled visit to the Community of Landashir.

Visits to the protectorate of Llabdey are not bound by the regulations of the Agency for Territories and Border Control. The borders are unmarked and the territories are open to the public and managed by international authorities.

Visitors who require consular assistance will be directed to the nearest embassy or consulate in the United Kingdom. The

Community of Landashir does not host any embassies or consulates in its territory.

Permanent residence and refuge are not guaranteed by the Landashir'n Government.

The numbers for emergency services in the United Kingdom are 112 or 999. All health and travel insurance for a trip to Landashir must be written out for the United Kingdom only.

There is no longer a Landashir'n currency. All payments must be in Pound Sterling.

Landashir does not issue visas or passports. Please **only** organise your visit with the Landashir'n Government.
